



How to check if my device is not carrier-locked?

For **iPhones**: To find out if your iPhone is carrier-unlocked, click [here](#).

For **Android** phones, go to phone Settings > Connections > Mobile networks > Network operators > Turn off Automatic option. If you can view other carrier available networks, your Android phone is likely not carrier-locked.

What devices support eSIM?
